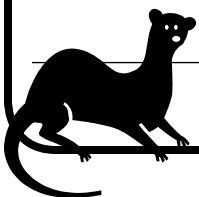

Listen to white-cheeked gibbon and siamang calls by touching the buttons.

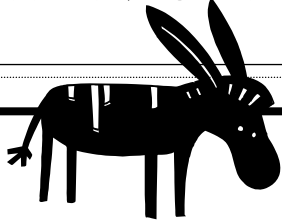

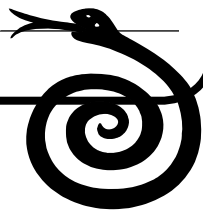
