PAYMENT

Payment in full must be received 2 weeks prior to the program date. This payment is <u>non-refundable</u> and may be made over the phone via credit card or a check made out to Friends of the National Zoo. Please be aware that checks can take an extra week or two to be received at the Zoo. Payment information will be sent after program is confirmed.

BUS PARKING

If you plan to bring and park a bus during your time at the Zoo you will need coordinate parking with them after your program has been confirmed. CANCELLATIONS

- > Cancellations received more than 2 weeks prior to the program(s) date will be honored and accrue no fees. If your school has already submitted payment, it will be refunded in full.
